## **Important Information**

#### Recommendations

#### Use only non-stretch fastening ropes or straps.

Please remove cargo and crossbars when putting vehicle through an automatic car wash.

Do not stow away the awning for long periods if it is wet. You must allow the awning material to dry completely before storing for extended periods of time. When rolling up the awning, avoid excessive bunching up of the material before stowing. The awning should be rolled up as neatly as possible following the instruction on page 9.

### In service maintenance checks

- All bolt connections should be checked after driving a short distance when you first install your roof racks.
- All bolted connections should be checked again at regular intervals (weekly is recommended, depending on road conditions, usage, loads and distances travelled).
- All bolted connections should be checked each time they are re-fitted.
- Off-road conditions are more rigorous. Check all bolted connections and your load more regularly.
- Ensure that your vehicle manufacturer's GVM, and gross axle weights are not exceeded (refer to vehicle owner's manual).

#### **Torque Settings:**

Unless stated otherwise in these instructions, all fasteners should be set to the following torque settings:







## **Load Ratings**

With the addition of an awning, the load capacity of your crossbars will have to be adjusted accordingly. Please ensure you use the vehicle manufacturer's maximum roof allowance if it is lower than the figure listed in supplement.

T3 - Step Ladder







