Load Ratings

When these roof racks are to be used on a vehicle that is driven off sealed roads, the manufacturer maximum roof load rating (to be found in the vehicle's User Manual) should be divided by a safety factor of **1.5**. For example, if the vehicle's maximum roof load rating is 70kgs\165lbs, these racks, when fitted to this vehicle should have no more than 46kgs/101lbs loaded on them.




