

Please refer to your vehicle manufacturers handbook for maximum carrying capacity. Always use the lower of the two figures. Load must be evenly distributed over the entire Pioneer. Weight of roof rack accessories is to be included in cargo allowance.

Torque settings

Unless stated otherwise in these instructions, all fasteners should be set to the following torque settings -M6: 4-5Nm (3-4lbs/ft), M8: 8-10Nm (6-7.5lbs/ft) and M10: 16-18Nm (12-13lbs/ft).

- Check Part No. and/ or Kit is correct for use with your vehicle
- Do not attempt to fit the rack system to your vehicle unless you fully understand these fitting instructions. Please direct any questions regarding fitting to the dealer from where the roof racks were purchased.
- Use only non-stretch fastening ropes or straps.
- The handling characteristics of the vehicle changes when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons we recommend you exercise extreme care when transporting wind-resistant loads. Special consideration must be taken into account when cornering and
- Although the system is tested and approved to AS1235-2000 / ISO 11154, off-road conditions can be much more rigorous. Extreme care must be taken in off road conditions

Recommendations:

It is essential that all bolt connections be checked after driving a short distance when you first install your roof racks. Bolt connections should be checked again at regular intervals (once a week is enough, depending on road conditions, usage, loads and distances travelled). You should also check the roof racks each time they are re-fitted. Always make sure to fasten your load securely. Please also ensure that all loads are evenly distributed and that the centre of gravity is kept as low as possible and must be entirely contained within the extents of the roof












1:Remove the backing tape from the Butyl Patches.2:Place over holes drilled. Once in place remove the rest of the protective tape from the top of the patches. This patch will provide the water tight seal.






Slide the following T-bols into the C channel of each track. 1x M8, 2x M6, 1x M8. Install the following O-rings on each T-bolt. 7mm on M8 and 6mm on M6. The T-Bolt on either end of the track does not use an O-ring.



Install 1x M8 T-bolt through each end cap. Slide the endcap assembly into the C channel

9 Fit the track to the canopy, ensure that the cutout on the track is at the rear of the canopy and each bolt is aligned with the corresponding hole.



Secure the track to the roof as follows:

M6: 1x M6 Nyloc knob [item 5]

M8: 1x M8 internal shakeproof washer [item 8]

1x M8x19mm flat washer [item 9]

1x M8 tri-star hex dial [item 10]
